

Media Kit Photo Shoot List



Headshots: Classic close-up shots of the performer's face, highlighting their expressions and features.

Full-body shots: To capture the performer's entire presence and body language.

Action shots: Dynamic images of the performer in motion, whether it's dancing, singing, playing an instrument, or performing a scene.



Posed shots: Different poses that convey various emotions and attitudes, such as confidence, vulnerability, joy, intensity, etc.

Costume shots: If the performer has multiple outfits or costumes, make sure to capture each one to show versatility.

Instrument/prop shots: If the performer uses any instruments or specific props during their act, take shots that focus on these elements.



Group shots: If there are multiple performers or collaborators, get shots that showcase their chemistry and teamwork.

Audience interaction: If applicable, capture moments where the performer is engaging with the audience.



Environmental shots: Incorporate the location or setting of the shoot to add context and depth to the images.

Backstage shots: Candid shots of the performer preparing, warming up, or interacting with others backstage.

Profile shots: Side-profile images that can emphasize the performer's unique facial features or silhouette.



Natural light shots: Utilize natural light to capture a softer, more organic look.

Studio light shots: Play with studio lighting setups to achieve more controlled and dramatic effects.
